

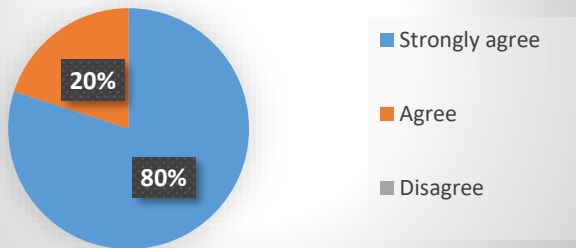


Broadway First School – Parent Questionnaire Results 2024/25

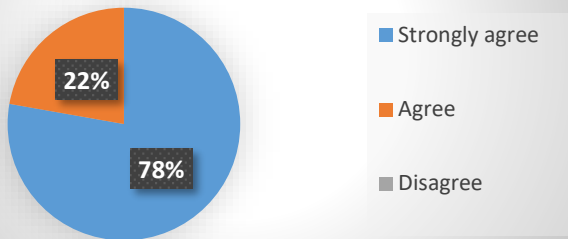
We appreciate feedback at any time so please do not hesitate in speaking to us if you have any questions or concerns. The results of the questionnaire are displayed below.

My child is happy at this school.



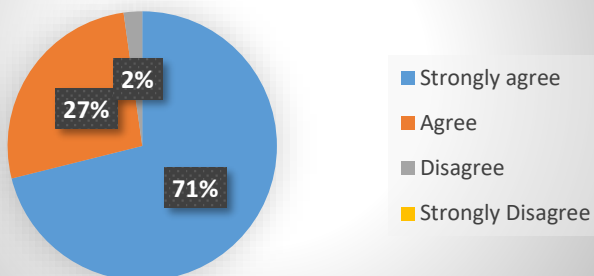
All respondents agreed or strongly agreed with this statement.

100% of parents acknowledge their children are safe at our school.

The school makes sure its pupils are well behaved.

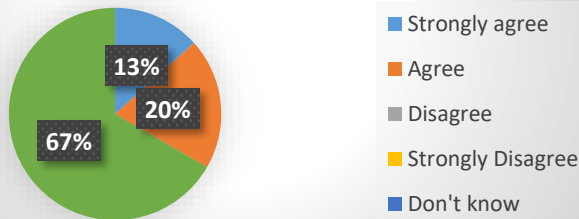


98% of parents believe behaviour is good at our school.

Like any school, we acknowledge that there are challenges at times, but observations by internal and external professionals consistently show children are engaged well in their learning and display positive behaviours around the school.

The children's behaviour is often commended by visitors to the school and on while on trips.

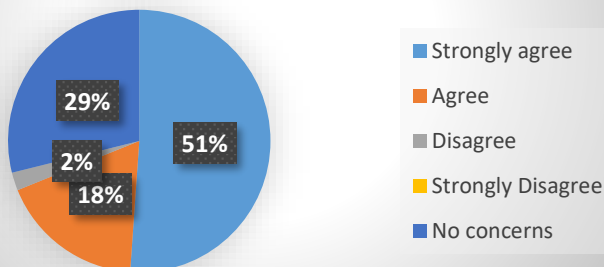
My child has been bullied and the school dealt with the bullying quickly and...



67% of parents stated their child had not been bullied.

The remaining 33% stated they strongly agreed or agreed that the school dealt with incidents effectively.

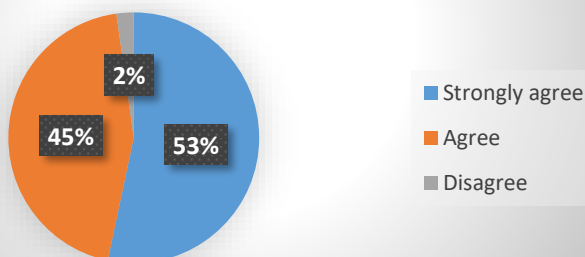
When I have raised concerns with the school they have been dealt with properly.



98% of respondents stated either they had no concerns or agreed that they were dealt with properly.

If you have a concern we would always want you to come a chat with the relevant member of staff so that a solution can be found in a respectful and amicable fashion.

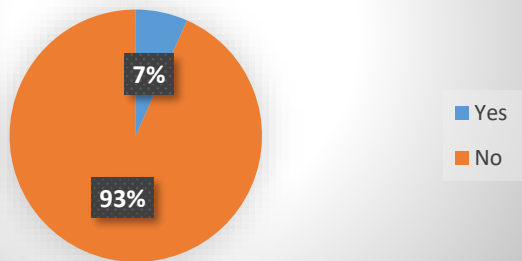
The school makes me aware of what my child will learn during the year.



98% of parents agreed that school does make them aware of learning.

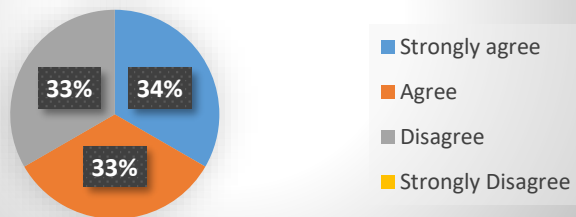

93% of the respondents did not have children with special educational needs.

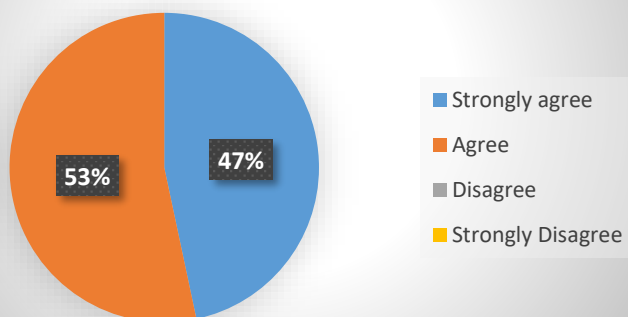
If yes, how strongly do you agree with this statement: 'My child has SEND and the school gives them they support they need.'



Of the 7% of parents that responded with a child that has special educational needs, 2 out of the 3 parents strongly agreed or agreed their child is well supported.

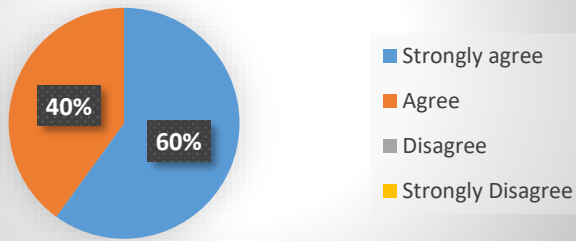

The school has high expectations for my child.



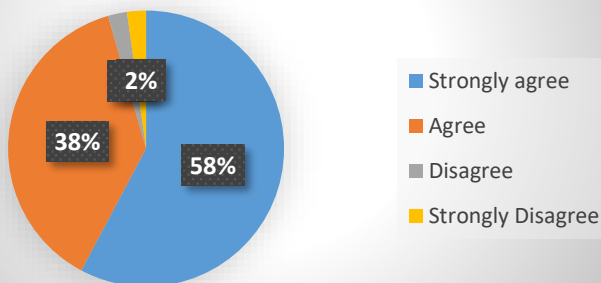
100% of parents strongly agreed or agreed with this statement.

The school lets me know how my child is doing.

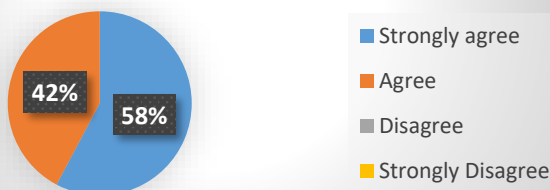


96% of parents agree that school informs them on how their child is doing.

Two parents' evenings are held in autumn and spring terms and the summer term sees an end of year report produced. It is a school's statutory duty to have just one parents' evening session and an annual school report each year.

Broadway First School delivers 13 different subjects throughout the year. Our curriculum is fully aligned to that of the National Curriculum.

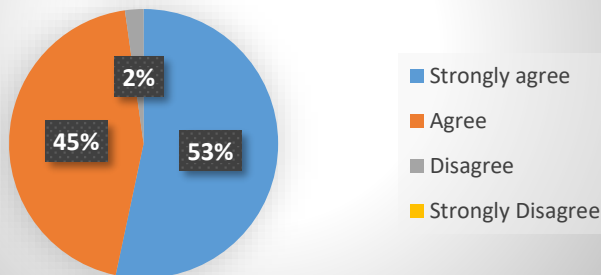
My child can take part in clubs and activities at this school.

We are making an effort to broaden opportunities beyond sport and increase the offer to our younger pupils. A survey was recently sent to parents regarding this.

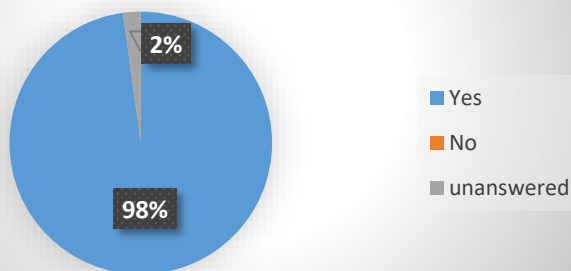
The school supports my child's wider personal development.



98% of parents strongly agree or agree that school supports personal development.

Personal Development is an area the school is particularly proud of. Indeed, our most recent Ofsted report stated Personal Development is exceptionally well supported. We develop children beyond the academic through our values, visits, visitors and our SMSC curriculum, which deals with a range of issues that prepare children in understanding how they can prosper within school and the wider community.
