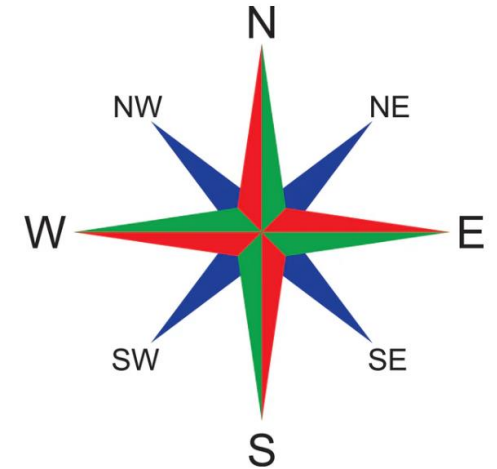
The UK

Light

Have you ever wondered how light is made? There are two types of light sources, natural and artificial. Natural light includes, the sun, stars and lightning, whilst artificial light is manmade e.g. torches. Light travels in straight lines and cannot bend therefore, if an object is put in front of a light source, it creates a shadow. Throughout this unit, we will also look at how to protect ourselves from the sunlight.
