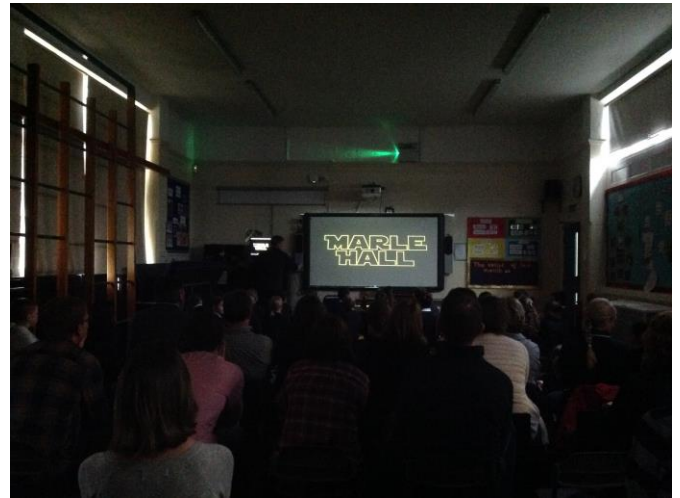


Dear Parents/Carers

We are running at the same time as Broadway Arts Festival as they have facilitated some incredible arts opportunities for the children. All are welcome to attend the concert and we really hope all of the older children can go. It is an incredible opportunity to show the local community how talented our children are.

On Tuesday Hilary Robinson and Martin Impney (authors) are coming in to work with children. They are then doing book signings on the Green.

Wednesday will be incredibly exciting! ArtBase will work in school for the day to create a large piece of work incorporating local animals and our school values ready to go up in the newly refurbished Reception area in September. Every child will contribute to this piece.

On Thursday 14th June it is our Sports Day. Children will be participating in team sports in the morning, then in the afternoon we will have individual races. Parents may join us for the afternoon, and the children may go home afterwards. More detail will be sent in a separate letter when we return.

Also next half term, Mr Poultney and Mrs Browning are redesigning the school newsletter. We want it to be the primary source of information and celebration.
