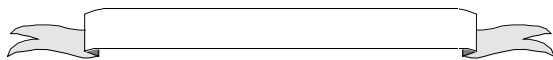

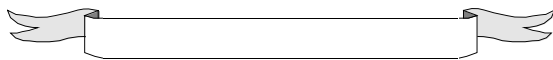

Wednesday	<p style="text-align: center;">Walk to Broadway Tower</p> <p>All children will be taking part in our annual walk to Broadway Tower. Children are to bring a packed lunch. Children that have ordered a school dinner will receive a packed lunch from the dinner company on this day. Make sure your child has plenty to drink.</p> <p>Children do not need to wear school uniform but should wear suitable clothes and footwear. Please send sun cream and a hat although the weather forecast looks cooler for next week.</p>
