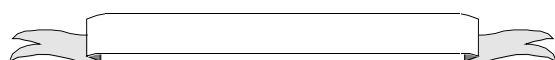

We're still requesting anyone with access to a van or trailer might be generous enough to help us remove some old display boards to the tip. Contact us if you feel you can help.



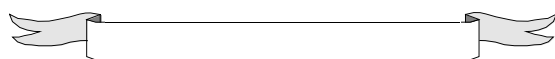

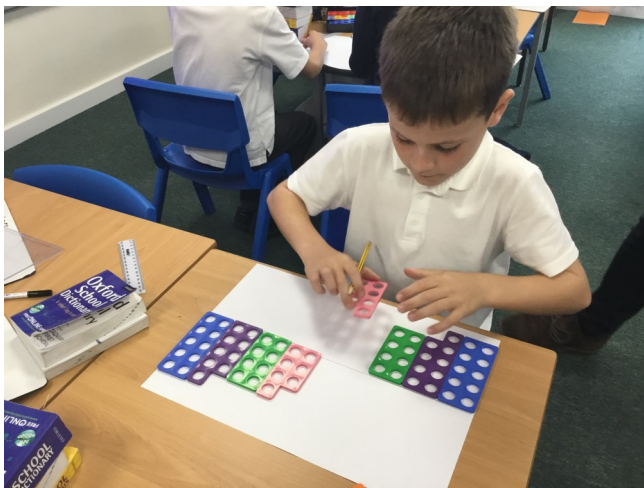
