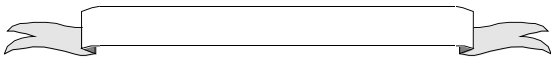


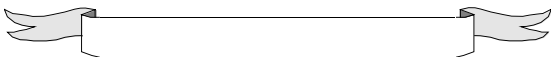

Children in the pre-school are not currently included in this government initiative but can obtain the vaccination from their GP surgery.

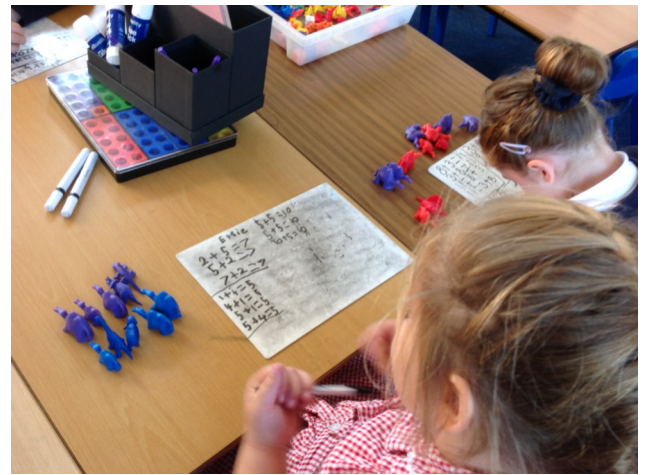
