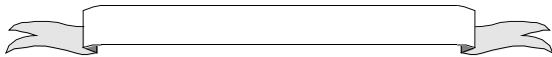




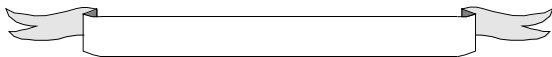

Messages from Dr Browning and Mr Poultney:

On Thursday , we invited new parents to our open morning. It was a huge success and our best turn out yet. It was wonderful to see how interest in our school is increasing all the time and recognition of all the hard work that the whole school community has contributed these past few years.

A few reminders:

- 1) With winter almost upon us can we all make the effort to ensure the children are sent to school with suitable clothing. The children spend a significant amount of time outside during the day and some are finding they are not equipped to stay warm at these times.
- 2) Your child has been sent home with a letter today regarding late collection at the end of the day. Please ensure you read this letter.
- 3) Finally, a polite reminder that parking should not take place on the grass verges opposite school. We have received complaints from local residents who are becoming frustrated with the destruction it leaves behind. Also, remember the 'Drop off zone' and double yellow lines are not for parking and in doing so you are preventing families from dropping their children off safely.

The children have made clay poppies which will be used during the Remembrance Service on Sunday at the War Memorial. It would be great if you could attend. This year the poppies are being sold for £2 with this being split equally between the Royal British Legion and the school.

On Monday, the children will be taking part in a Remembrance Service at the Catholic church. If your child has purchased a poppy please ensure they wear it on this day. The service will act as a reminder of what remembrance symbolises and give the children an opportunity to pay their respects.
