



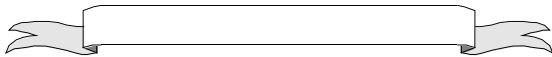

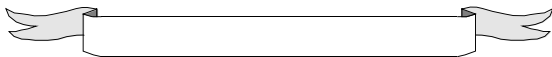

Christmas Lunch for the Children

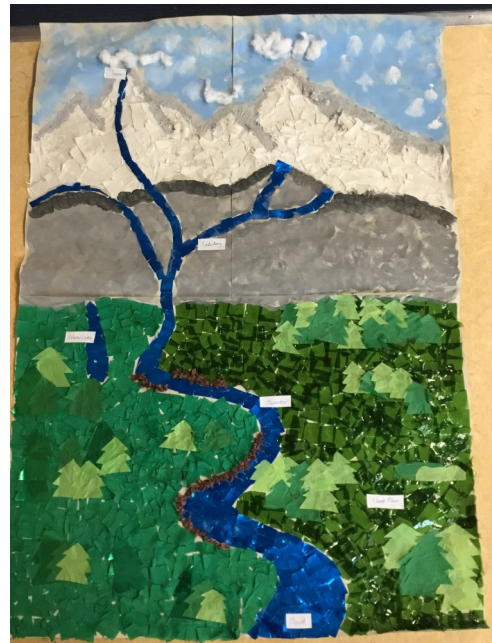
