



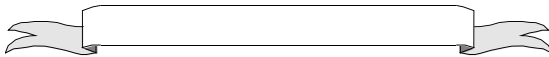

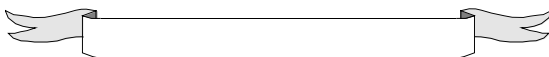

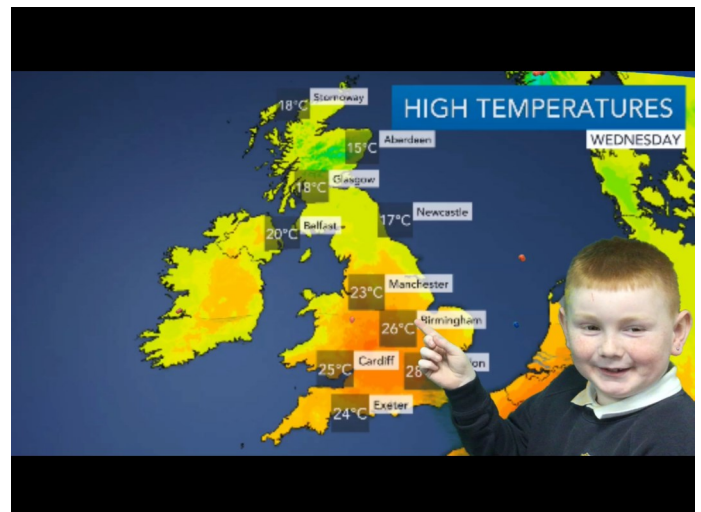
Buzzards
