



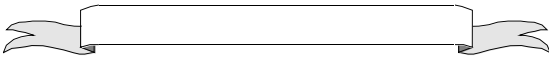

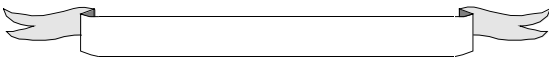

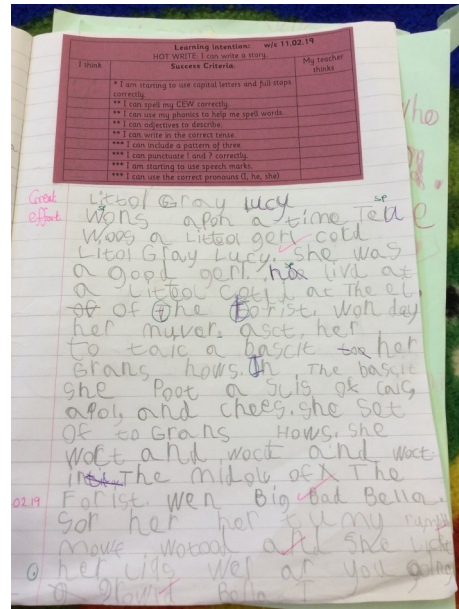


Foxes
