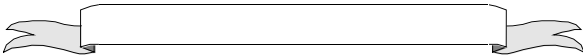

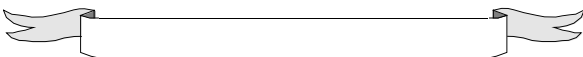

Buzzards

Buzzard Class were very excited to deliver their class assembly to family members this morning. The children have spent all week researching facts about the famous moon landing in 1969. They researched what life was like in 1969, who the lucky people were to travel to the moon, the importance of mission control and even facts about our solar system! They did themselves and their families proud.

In Maths this week we have been learning how to find a quarter of a number and a shape. In Science, we were measuring water by counting in twos and fives.

Continuing our exploration into volcanoes we have spent this week, in science lessons, exploring rocks formed by heat. The children have drawn and experimented with these igneous rocks and have identified their properties. Ask your child how many igneous rocks they can remember.

This week the Owl class visited the pond to observe the frog spawn and talk about the life cycle of a frog. We watched a video on how the tadpoles will hatch and their growth into a frog. We also made our dinosaur land and modelled in it on our maps using mudroc.
