



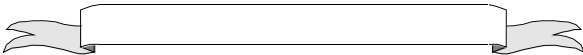

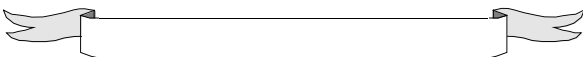

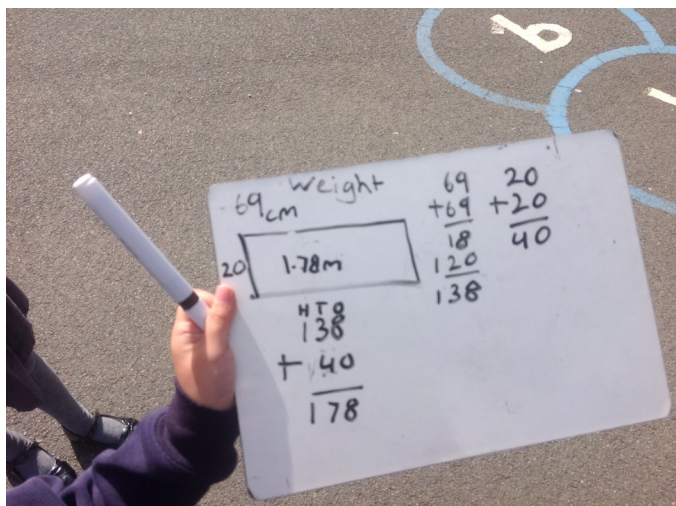
Please note the school office will **not** be manned next Monday 1st April, so please direct any alternative pick up arrangements to the class teacher or TA at drop off.
