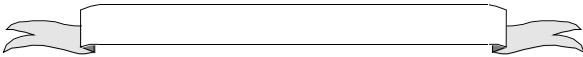

Messages from Dr Browning and Mr Poultney:

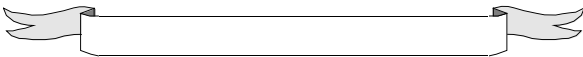
