



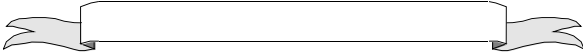

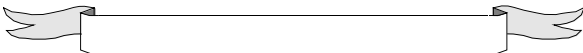

This week we have been learning about e-safety and what we should do if something pops up on the computer screen that we don't like. We learnt the song below to remind us.

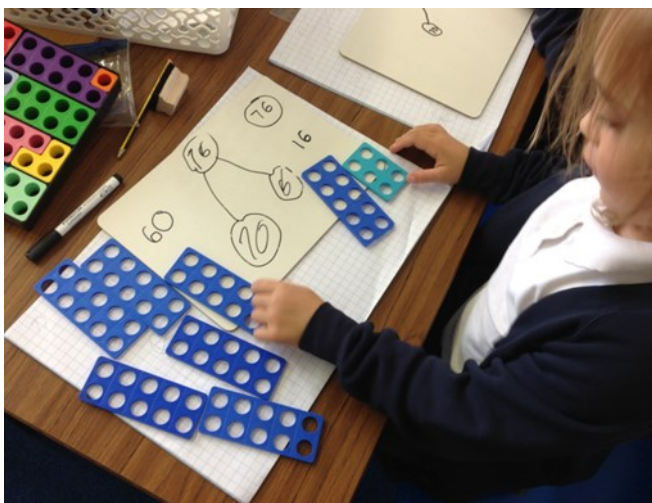
