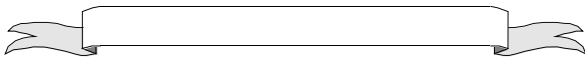

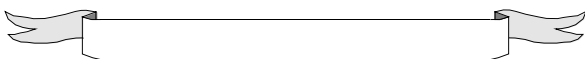

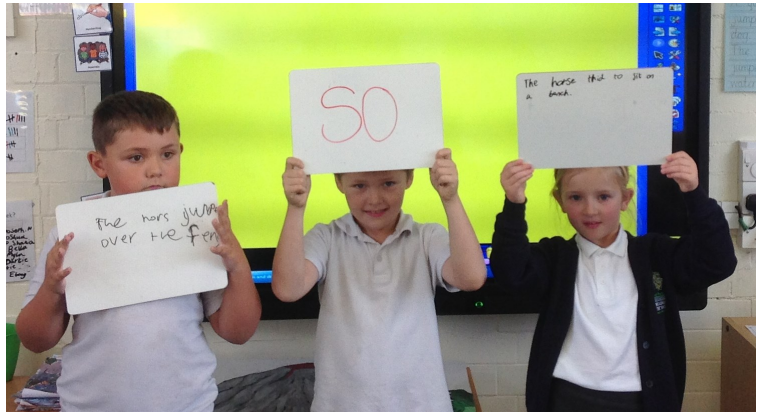


Rockies
