Firstly, I'd like to thank you for bearing with us this time last week when the weather caused all sorts of chaos. Thankfully, this week has been a great deal calmer.

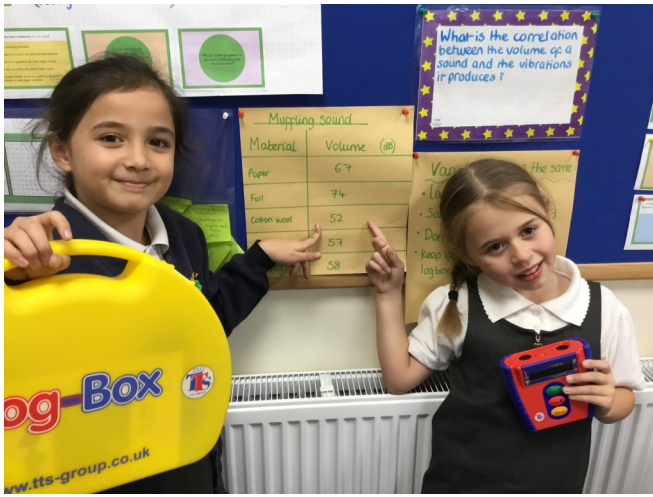
I'd like to thank those of you that visited the school to attend Rockies' Inspire Workshop. I hear the session was very enjoyable.
