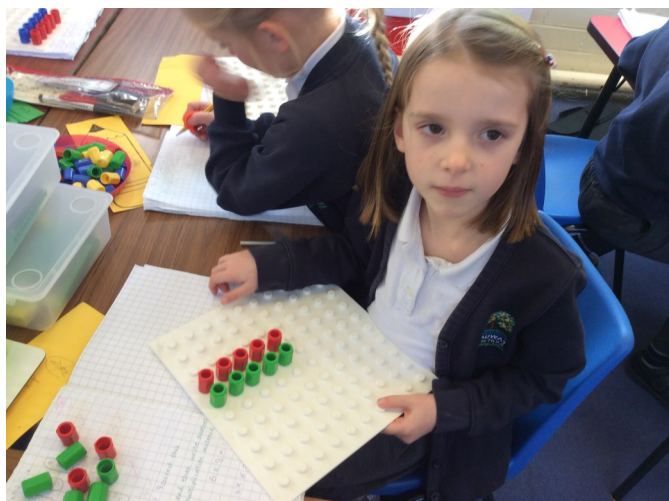
Atlas
