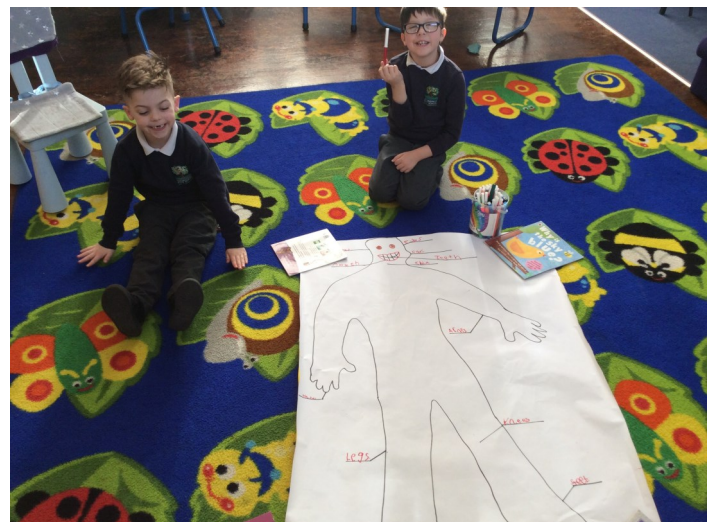


Alps
