**School Lunches in September**

## WAC Notice

In September we are making some changes regarding our before and after school provision, Wrap Around Club;

Invoices will continue to be issued at the end of each month but will be issued using the Worcestershire County Council finance system. This will enable parents to pay online as well as other options, including using childcare vouchers. Payment by cash or cheque at the school office will no longer be permissible, with the exception of settling any outstanding fees from this academic year.

If your account is in arrears from this academic year, your booking will not be accepted until the arrears are clear. Please speak to the office if you feel this will cause any issues for you.

If you book your child/ren into WAC and cancel with less than 48 hours notice, you will be charged the full amount.

Under the current covid-19 restrictions, adhoc bookings will be very difficult to manage as we have to ensure that bubbles are not mixed as much as possible. This takes careful planning so please ensure you book in line with your work schedule.
