Messages from Mr Poultney:

The Department for Education released guidance yesterday setting out plans for September. The good news is that ALL children will be expected to return to school after the summer holiday.

However, there will still be a number of measures schools have to follow. This means that we will not be expecting school to return to how it was pre-lockdown. We are still making sense of what we can and can't do but the key messages are:

- Children will remain in 'bubbles' but these can now be a class.
- Children at primary age will not be expected to socially distance with other children in their class bubble.
- Bubbles should not mix meaning that assemblies, lunch time and other gatherings will not be possible in the way we are used to.

The guidance contains a great deal of information and we will be planning how to implement it during the coming weeks. There will be some significant challenges to overcome such as how we drop off and collect children in a safe way without disrupting the school day. We also need to bear in mind the recovery of the curriculum and how we can all work together to get children back on track as quickly as possible during the autumn term.

I know I can count on your support to help us put our future plans into place and make what will be a huge step a success. Thank you.

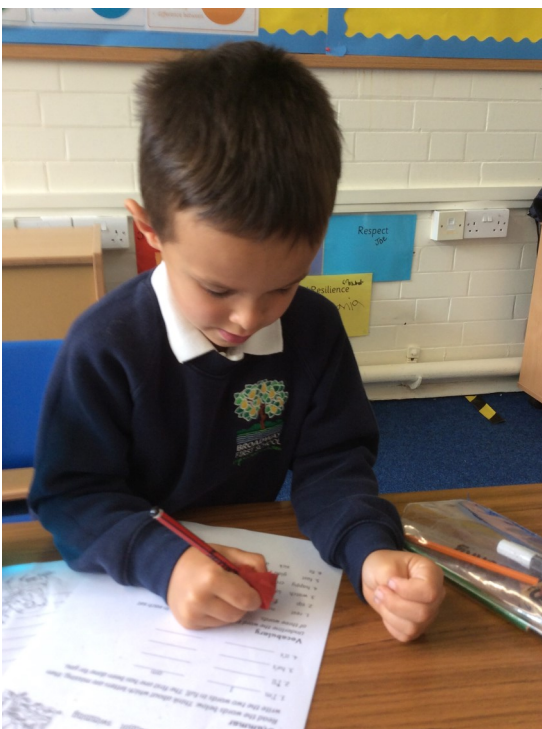
Key Workers Group 2
