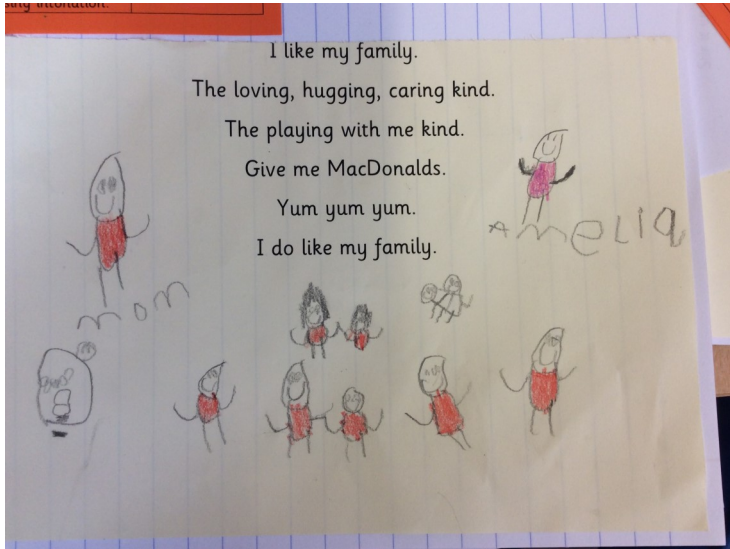


Starfish
