



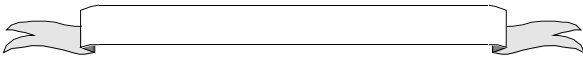

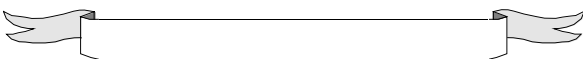

Message from Mr Poultney:

There's been a few letters sent out this week. Firstly, the NHS sent out some flyers encouraging families to engage in the Lateral Flow Testing at home. Staff have been taking this test twice a week since January and the NHS would like this to be extended to families. More details are on the flyers as to how this can be done.

The second letter was sent out yesterday and related to a change in how children will be separated outdoors after Easter. All other measures will remain in place and we ask parents play their part in following the rules outside of the school day.

Please be reminded that school should be notified of any child that tests positive for coronavirus during the Easter holiday. Please use Class Dojo to message both the class teacher **and** myself if this happens. If the positive test or start of symptoms are within 2 days of the last day at school then other people in contact with that child will be affected and we will need to ensure measures are put into place.

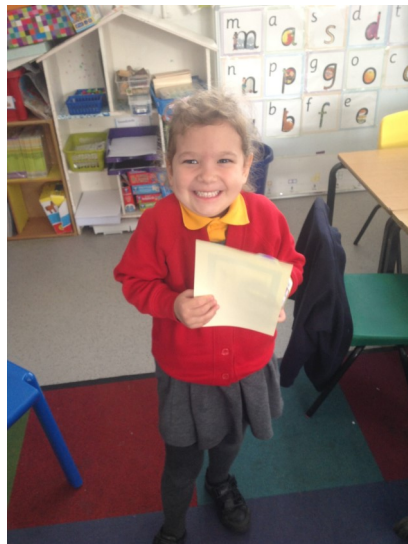
Turtles
