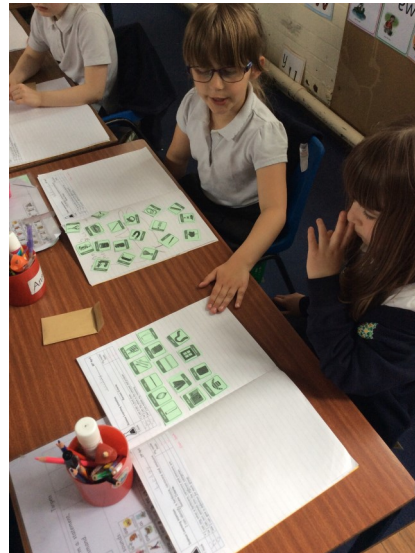
Seahorses
