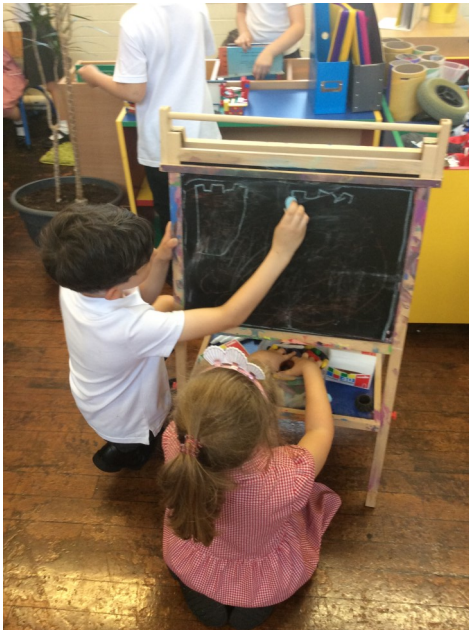
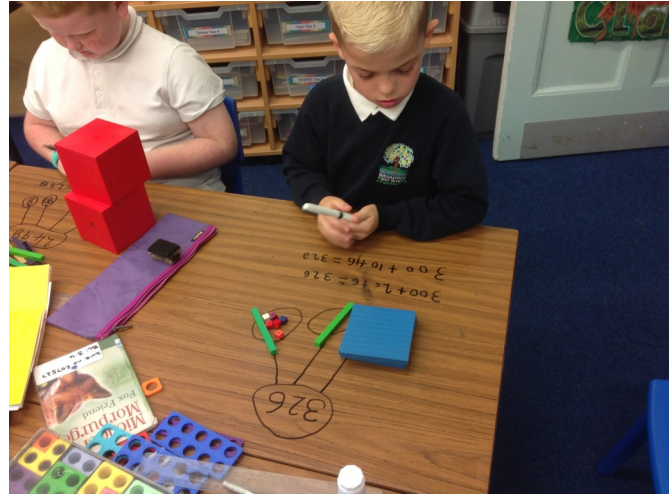


### Oak
