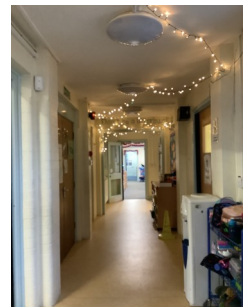

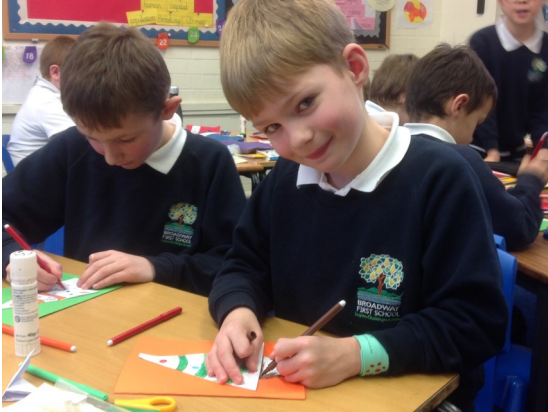

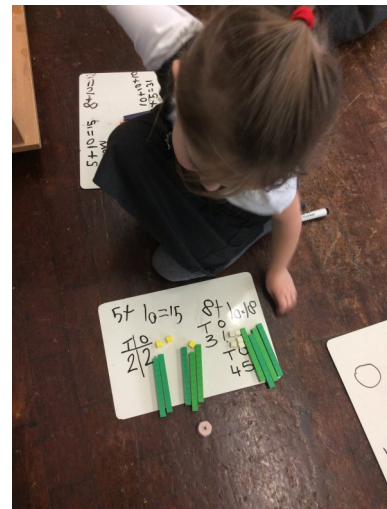


Willow

Music Lessons with Severn Arts

If your child is interested in learning an instrument during school hours, the school have an arrangement with Severn Arts. Tutors come into school at a prearranged time and you can choose to have a 20 or 30 minute lesson on a weekly basis. Tuition costs are £12.90 per 20 minutes but this cost can be split if your child participates in a group lesson, (usually no more than 4 children at once). They have many instruments available including guitar, piano, violin, flute, trombone, to name but a few!!
