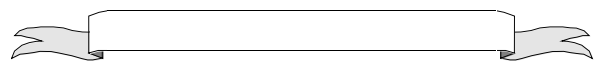

Enjoy your weekend and we'll see you on Monday.



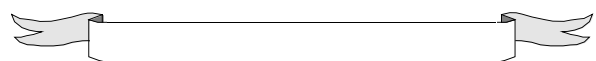

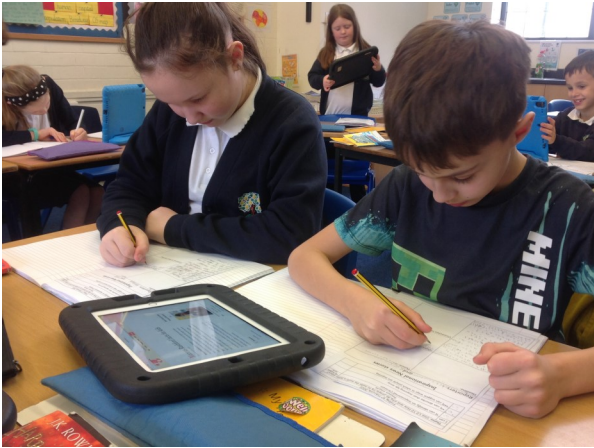

## Oak

We are very excited to check the results of our egg experiment in Science. We were investigating the effects of water, lemonade, coffee, tea, apple juice and vinegar have on our enamels by investigating the effects they have on the shell of an egg. We carried out a fair test. In English, we are enjoying the story, Kaspar Prince of Cats and pupils have written an alternative opening. In addition to this, we used an emotion graph to demonstrate a character's feelings at different parts or events in the story.
