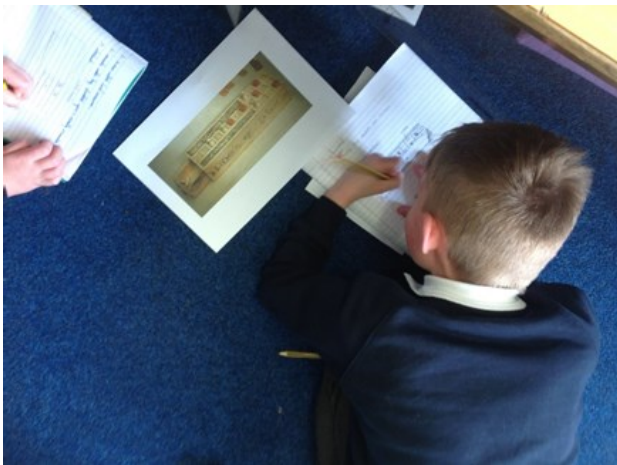




## Oak
