

In Year 5 Gymnastics, pupils have been learning symmetrical balances and working together to form a sequence. English, Topic and Computing were cross-linked this week, to pull all the information we know about the Mayans into a booklet. All pupils worked efficiently and effectively with their talking partners researching and exploring a variety of sources to gather the information required.

This week, we have been focussing on building our Egyptian shadufs in DT. Over the past few weeks, we have been evaluating materials and exploring design ideas before we built our own this week. We used hacksaws and glue guns to join materials together that we had carefully selected and measured. We then tested our final products and suggested improvements for next time. In our Maths work, we revisited our addition and subtraction skills by adding and subtracting different masses.
