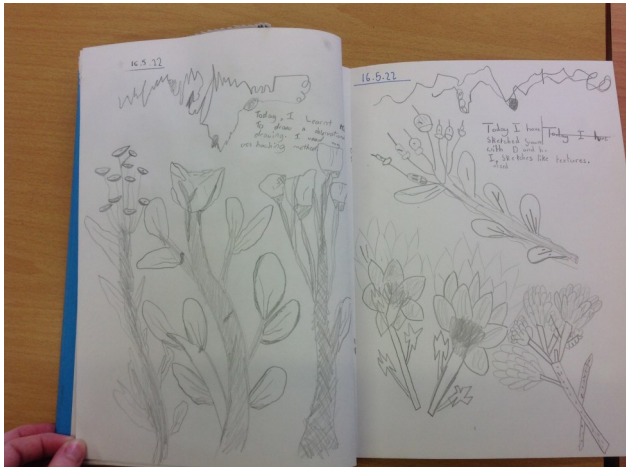


Jubilee is fast approaching. We are having our own celebrations on Thursday and the children are invited to wear red, white or blue. Please see page 3 for more details about the our plans.

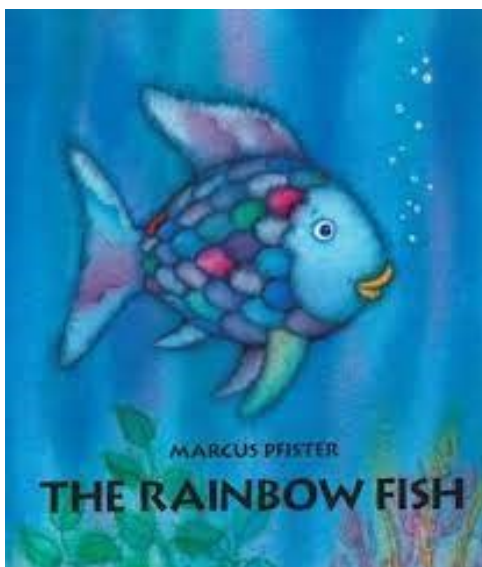


Willow
