Have a super half term break. Try to find some time to keep your children reading and we shall see you all in June.

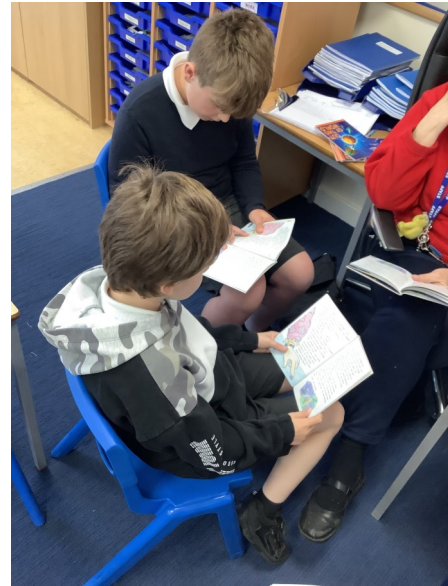
