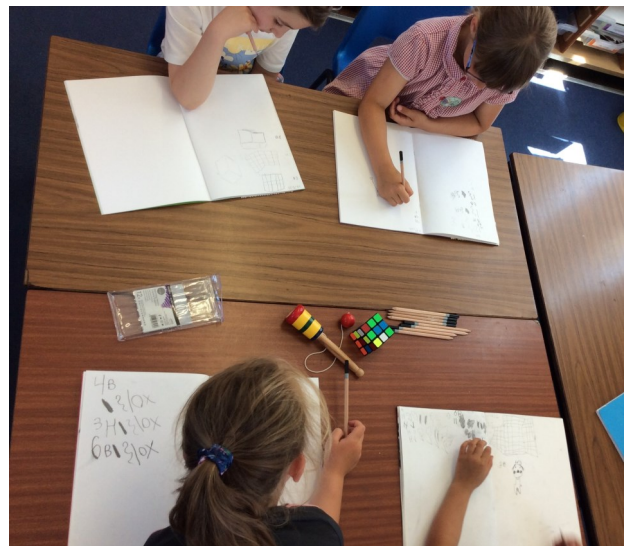
Maple
