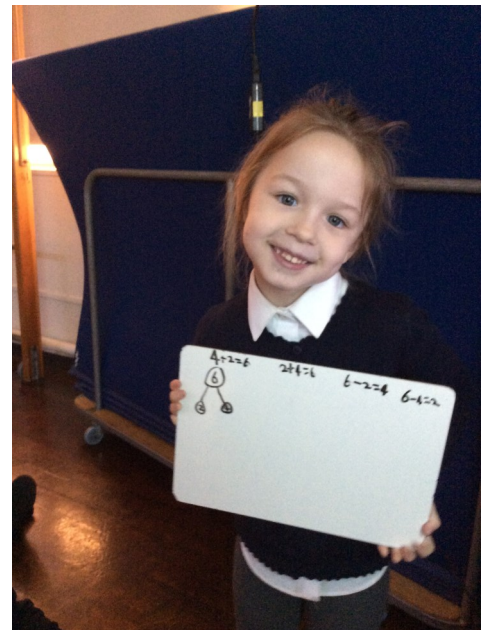


Pandas
