We all hope you have a super weekend.

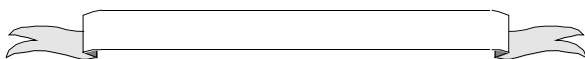

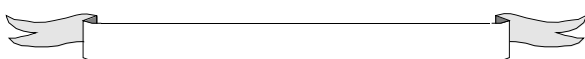
