Message from Mr Poultney:

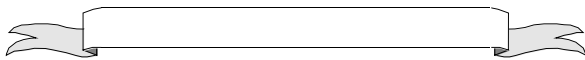

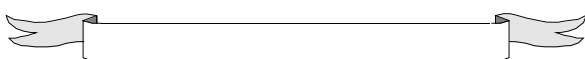

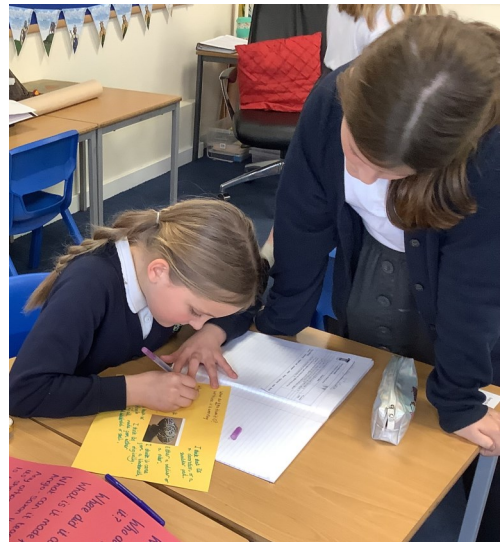

In Topic, we have been working in groups to discuss whether sources are primary or secondary and predicting what we thought the items were used for.
