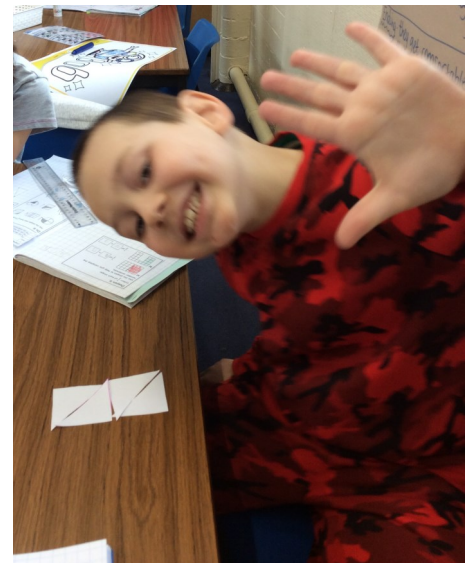


## Pandas

This week, as part of our Science topic about plants, Pandas have been learning about the life cycle of a tomato plant. We then applied our scientific knowledge as we planted young tomato plants with Bob. Hopefully, our tomato plants will start producing plants in a few months. In our English lessons, we have been busy learning about Marie Curie and writing biographies about her life.

## Koalas

This week in Koala class, we have been learning about how we would plan our journey and travel to Africa from Broadway. We used maps and globes to plot our route, looked at a flight tracker and drew our own maps. In Science, we learned about how animals find food in their habitats. We learned new vocabulary such as carnivore, herbivore, omnivore and producer. Year 2s have impressed me with their instruction writing about 'How to make an egg box dragon' and Year 1s have been doing some great work in Maths, making numbers from 20-50 with base 10.



## Tree Frogs

Class 1 has had a great week learning in Science about living and non-living things and habitats. We visited Slimbridge Wetlands and loved learning in the 'Wetland Wonders' teaching session, observing the birds and playing in the adventure parks, especially Welly Boot Land! In Maths, Reception children have continued learning in numbers to 20. In Literacy we are independently applying our phonics knowledge by recording what we know about habitats and creatures that live in different habitats. A super week, Class 1!



## Pre-School

This week in Preschool we have shared the stories, “The Go Away Bird and Wildlife Jack”, enjoying the repeating phrases. In Forest School we built a bird hide, made footprint traps and bird feeders and in Maths we have continued to use seeds to compare sizes and sort by characteristics, finishing with planting pumpkin seeds. Great engagement Preschool, well done!!
