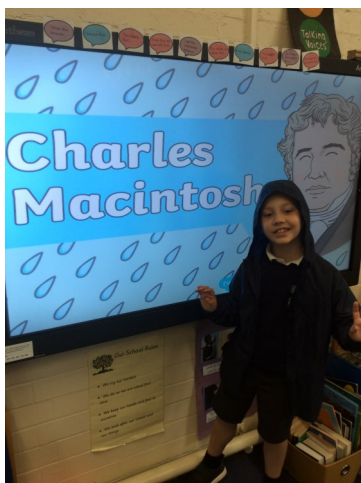
Pandas
