This is likely to see us performing above the national average once results are published. In Year 2, the children completed their SATs assessments with an impressive 100% meeting the required standard in reading and Maths. In writing, 70% met the expected standard. Again, we expect these results to be above the national average in reading, writing and maths once figures are officially published. Well done to the children and staff involved. It caps off a highly successful year for Broadway First School following our Ofsted inspection in March.

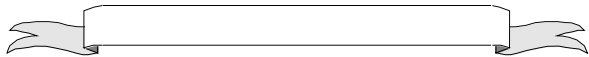
With one week to go, there's still plenty to look forward to with the tower walk, water fun day plus the main games and leavers' service for our Year 5s.

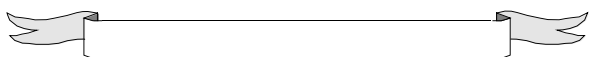

School Lunch Orders for New Academic Year

Class Catering have contacted us to say that all parents will be able to order lunches for the next half term from 4pm on Friday 25th August. This enables them sufficient time to set up their whole systems for the new academic year.

A reminder will be sent out during the holidays to ensure your child has lunch in their first week back. We would like to remind you that all children in Reception, Year 1 & Year 2 receive free school lunches and the daily cost is rising to £2.50 per day for Preschool, Year 3, Year 4 & Year 5 children in September.

End of Term Arrangements

- Monday 17th July** All Year 5 to Main Games at Fladbury. Children need to come to school in their full PE kit, with a named, packed lunch **FROM HOME** and enough drinks for the day.
- Tuesday 18th July** Year 5 BBQ & Rounders 4.30 pm – 6.00 pm.
- Wednesday 19th July** All Years from Reception through to Year 5 are going on the annual Broadway Tower Walk. All children need to come to school dressed in comfortable bottoms, (not jeans), their school PE top and sensible trainers or walking shoes. Class Catering will be providing sandwich only options on this day and they will be delivered to the Tower for lunchtime.
- Thursday 20th July** Our annual beach day with water fun is taking place!! All children need to wear clothes that you don't mind getting wet and bring in a change of clothes and a beach towel from home in a named bag. Lunches as normal.
- Friday 21st July** Leavers assembly at **10.30 am** on the playground. Everyone is welcome to attend this but if the weather is poor and we have to move this to the school hall, only Year 5 parents will be given priority. All parents are invited to come in for midday to have a picnic on the field with their child/ren. At 1.00 pm, children will go inside to collect their belongings, including everything off their pegs and are then free to leave.

Please note there is NO WAC after school on the 21st. Breakfast club is open as normal.

With all of the above, please bear in mind what the weather is doing and send sunhats, sun cream or rain coats accordingly. The British summer is very changeable!!
