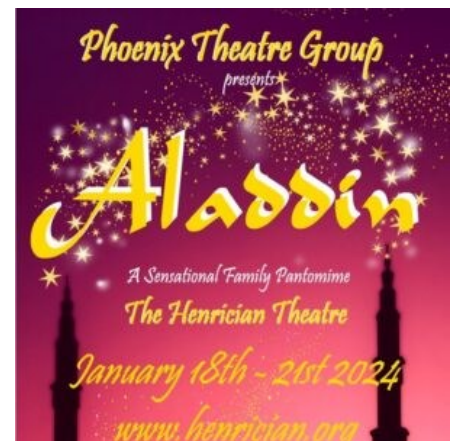
Congratulations!

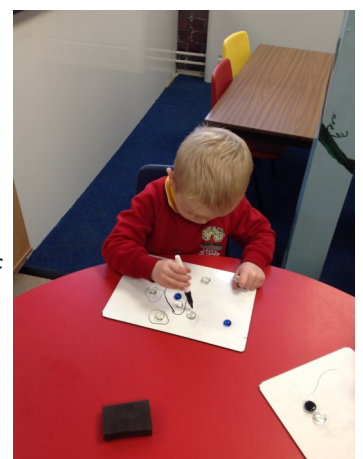
Please note there is no cold option available on this day but you are still welcome to bring in a packed lunch from home.
