## Wonderland

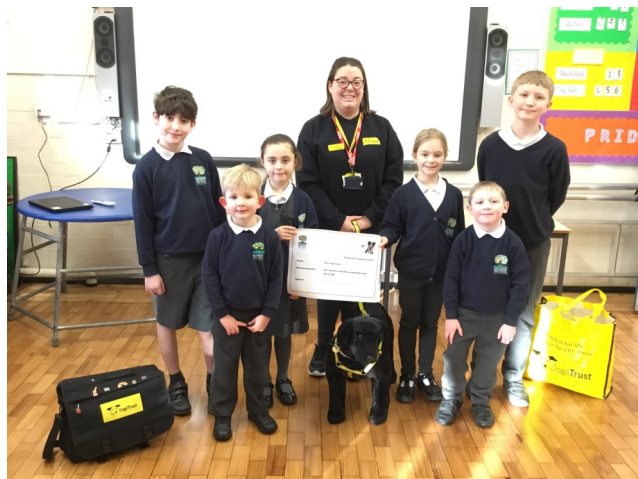
