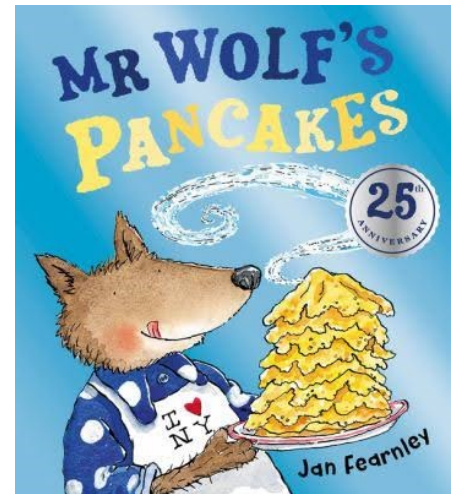
## Wonderland
