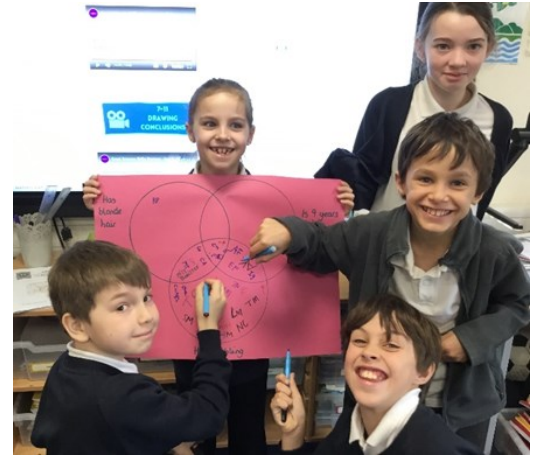


Narnia

We then combined these skills in our own enquiry to test how permeable different materials were, in preparation for our next DT project. In our English lessons, we have looked at what makes an exciting introduction and written our own. On Thursday, we enjoyed Bob working with us and planted two different varieties of potatoes. We weighed them before planting and will weigh our crop when we harvest them to calculate the profit. What a busy but very fun week!

Every day, they have been developing their enquiry skills to prepare them for their big enquiry on Friday investigating microfibres in fabrics. In History, they were able to explore different artefacts from the Viking period, and used prior knowledge to make predictions as to what each item was. Finally, in Maths, they have finished their topic of length and perimeter by practising finding the perimeter of rectangular shapes. Well done, Hogwarts!

This week in Class 2, we have had a great time taking part in British Science Week. The children have really been like little Scientists! They have come up with lots of questions, gathered evidence, used tables/charts and carried out their own investigations. We have also had lots of fun in PE, continuing to learn more about dance. This week, we created a dance routine working in 'canon'. Well done everyone.



Wonderland

This week in British Science week, Class 1 used our 'Working Scientifically', skills to investigate materials and how these can be changed, such as mixing ingredients to make playdough, making jelly, exploring water proof materials for the Three Little Pigs house and making popcorn in Forest School. We also looked at whether ice or chocolate would make a good house for them, observing what happens when they are heated and cooled. We learnt about measure and time in Maths and had lots of fun discovering how many times we can do an activity in 1 minute- such as hopping and writing our name. In Literacy, we sequenced how to make a jam sandwich and wrote the instructions.

In Preschool this week we have shared the story, 'Pete's Perfect Pizza Party' and continued to look at alliteration. We made our own muffin pizzas to celebrate this great book.
