Oz

This week in Oz Class, we have continued our learning about Scotland and compared three locations; Glasgow, Isle of Skye and Loch Ness. We have loved all of the freshly baked Scottish shortbread coming in from home - yum! In Science, we conducted a fair test to answer the question; 'Does the oldest child have the longest forearm?' We used rulers to carefully measure each other's arms and gather our data. Also, we've learned about Scottish artist, Shirley MacArthur, and experimented with oil pastels to draw lines similar to the ones in her vibrant highland cow drawings. In Maths, both Year 1 and 2 have started to learn about fractions and have done some great work with recognising and finding halves. Well done Oz Class!

We looked at the different features and talked about how we could tell if they are new or old and became architects ourselves by designing a new or AN old building.
