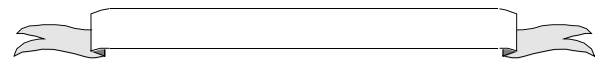

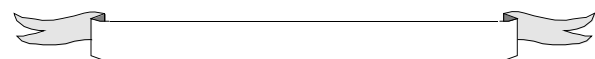

The Friends are running a raffle at the show with some truly great prizes. Make sure you're in it to win it.

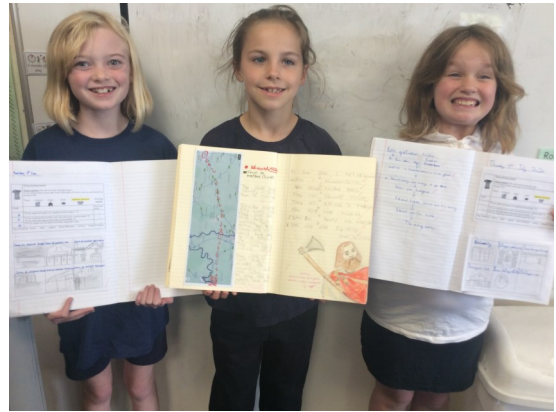

Narnia

This week, in Narnia Class, we have been taking part in lots of show rehearsals in preparation for the final performances next week. We have also been practising our rounders batting and fielding, ready for the parents' match. In Topic, we have written persuasive adverts to come to Evesham and learn all about Simon De Montfort. We also looked at the route the soldiers took, crossing the river at Kempsey. It's been a busy week with lots of exciting things on the horizon!



Hogwarts

This week, Hogwarts have been busy practising the school show with Narnia. In Maths, we have been interpreting different charts, including bar charts, pictograms and line graphs. Finally, in Music, we have composed our own melodies using the notes D, E and F. We have explored using crotchets and minims in different patterns and represented this on a staff. We then practised our compositions to perform to the class.

Oz

This week in Oz class, we had another look at the old toys from the museum and took a closer look at the Lego bricks, I Spy book, Etch a Sketch and a pencil case from 1927. We drew and labelled them from oldest to newest. In Science, we conducted an experiment where we wrote invisible messages using lemon juice on plain paper and then put them in the oven. We made predictions about what we thought might happen and magically, our writing appeared after being in the oven! In Maths, we have continued learning about shape and this week, have learned about vertical lines of symmetry and counted edges and faces on 3D shapes. In Art, we chose a toy from the classroom environment and carefully sketched a still life drawing. Well done Oz Class.

This week, Wonderland class enjoyed a further two settling in days for our new Reception and Preschool children and loved getting to know our new friends a bit better. In class, we read the book 'Dear Greenpeace' and spoke about ocean pollution. We also made fishing rods and fished for rubbish from our water trays. We also made a poster about ways we could help the planet. In Maths, Reception children have continued to work on our positional language, building obstacle courses and drawing maps. Well done Wonderland class.

School Lunch Orders for Autumn Term

I have been informed today that school lunch orders for the Autumn term can be ordered from **FRIDAY 23RD AUGUST**. To refresh your memory, I attach the full details on how to order lunches online and the menu choices, (on a 3-week rolling programme).

Sodexo have informed us that unfortunately, due to the mandatory increase in wages and the cost of food and fuel, they have had to increase their lunch costs to £2.78 per day. If your child is in Reception, Year 1 and Year 2 they will receive free school lunches, *regardless of circumstances*.

However, if your personal financial circumstances have changed, please use the attached information from the Worcestershire County Council Free School Meals team, as you may be eligible beyond Year 2. Having FSM status, does not simply entitle your child to free lunches, it also offers other benefits too, such as half price school trips including the Year 4 & 5 residential, 2 free after school activity clubs per term, some free WAC sessions per week, (discretionary depending on need) as well as monetary supermarket vouchers for the school holidays.
