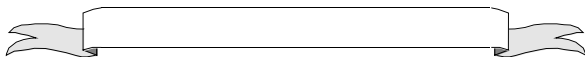

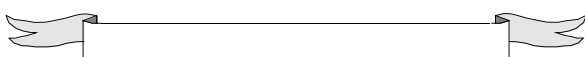

Enjoy your weekend.

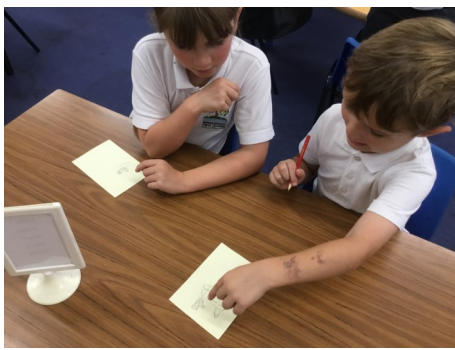

Donaldson (Class 1)

This week, Donaldson Class loved looking at photos of our class when we were babies and talking about how we have changed as we have grown up into big girls and boys in school! We talked about what we can do now that we couldn't as a baby- like eat food we can chew with our teeth, sit up, walk, run, we are taller and have more hair now too! We read 'Paper Dolls' and made our own paper chains of our family. We also looked at pictures of special buildings around Broadway and talked about places that are important of special to us, like the park, library and our school. We also made our own maps. In maths we matched pictures and objects and have begun to sort objects into 2 sets, making up our own rule- such as 'pine cones and not pine cones' Well done Donaldson class- another busy week!



Dahl (Class 2)

In Dahl Class this week, we have been learning about how to locate where we live on a map of the United Kingdom. We made our own flip book all about where we live. In Science, we experimented by observing what happened when we placed lilies and gypsophila into a mixture of water and food colouring. The results were amazing - especially after leaving them overnight! In Computing, we chose to use iPads to scan QR codes around the classroom and learned about being a good friend online in our E-safety sessions. Well done everyone!

Seuss (Class 3)

This week in Seuss class, we have been writing our explanation text about the Mystery of Stonehenge. We used fronted adverbials and explored the best way to organise our ideas around a theme, using sub-headings. Not only that, but in science we have been looking at skeletons and naming a variety of bones. On Thursday, we went swimming. Furthermore, we had lots of fun in the pool, learning new strokes and water safety. It has been an exciting, fun and busy week. Well done Seuss Class!



Morpurgo (Class 4)

In Science this week, we have been learning how to read food labels to identify the nutritional value of different food. We practised reading the information on packaging, before presenting this information on a bar chart. In Computing, we have been learning how to use search engines safely, and explored the differences between different search engines, such as Google, Bing and Duck Duck Go!

Laugh 'n' Learn Preschool

In 'Laugh and Learn' preschool this week, we made our own toffee apples in forest school, enjoyed the story of Super duck in our phonics sessions and created our own Super duck characters.

In our maths sessions we began to look at shapes and built a range of models using a variety of shapes. We also enjoyed singing "London bridge is falling down" and sharing the story "Crash Boom".
