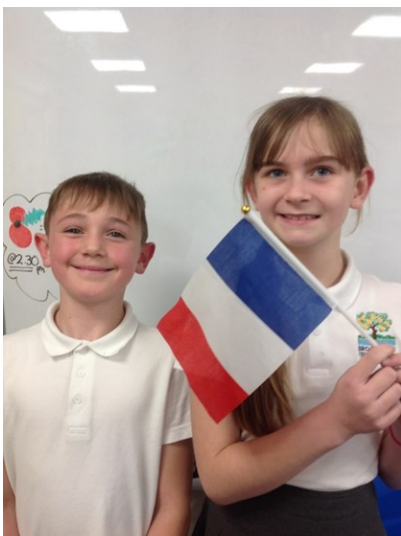


## Dahl (Class 2)

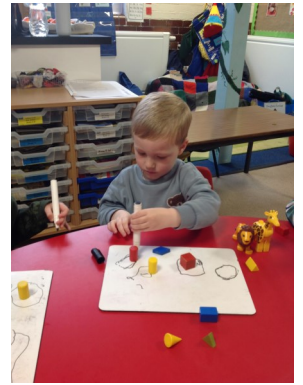
## Morpurgo (Class 4)
