Donaldson (Class 1)

In Donaldson this week, we have enjoyed drawing club and story dough around the book 'The Colour Monster' and creating a new friend with magical abilities for the Colour Monster. We have enjoyed a range of activities around love and linked to Valentine's day. We read the book 'The Love Monster' and made our own love monsters using different tools, such as forks and googly eyes. We have made our own Valentine's cards and biscuits too! Dahl (Class 2)



We have had a brilliant week in Dahl Class. At the beginning of the week, we finished our Ferocious Fire topic by baking some bread rolls from scratch which we imagined was just like what the baker did in Pudding Lane. We all had a turn at kneading the dough and they turned out brilliantly! We also invited Class 4 into our classroom to have a look and ask questions about our Great Fire of London moving pictures. We found out what our new topic is by finding different objects in a feely bag - all of the clues led to... Africa! We created some African art using different tribal patterns for inspiration and adding silhouettes of African animals. We also discovered what our new Science topic is by finding and scanning ten QR codes around the room which revealed ten different animal habitats. Have a lovely half term everyone!

This week in Class 3, we have been very creative. We have used inspiration from Antoni Gaudi's artwork to create colourful masterpieces. We have also looked at light and shadow which has resulted in some beautiful creations using shade, tone and reflection. We have also finished off our Creative Write in English. We have had a super busy week in Morpurgo Class! We have been busy in Computing, recording our final videos and then learning how to upload and edit them using software on the laptops. In DT, we looked at different types of bridges such as suspension bridges, arch bridges and cantilever bridges, before constructing our very own models. Finally, we enjoyed some time by the fire, toasting marshmallows, and singing songs, during our final Forest School session.

Laugh 'n' Learn Preschool

In preschool this week, we have been out for a shape walk and continued our learning on shapes and positional language. We have enjoyed some listening games and especially loved the game 'The Noisy Neighbour' where we had to recognise the hidden sounds. In circle time, we talked about our class rule 'Keep our hands and feet to ourselves' and read the book 'Feet are not for kicking'. We told Morris (our magical maths magician puppet) what we could use our feet for and had some great answers, such as backflips, swimming, cycling, jumping on a trampoline and gymnastics.
