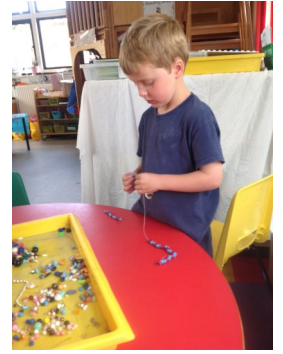




### Donaldson (Class 1)

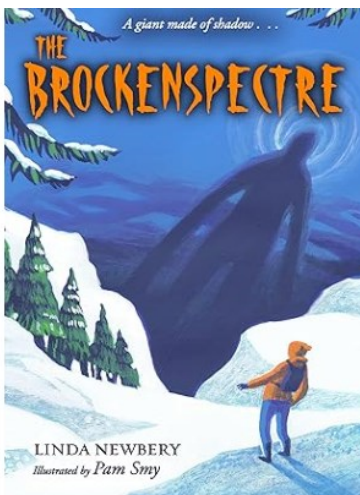
### Dahl (Class 2)

We have also been busy practising our play, celebrating World Music Day and looking at body proportion in Art, we are going to be using sculpture using wire. In English, we have been looking at descriptions and focusing on "The Brockenspectre". We are using this text as inspiration for when we write character descriptions with use of Similes and metaphors. Well done everyone!

Pre-school have really enjoyed watching the caterpillars grow and talking about the changes we have observed. We enjoyed the story, 'The very Hungry caterpillar' and made our own versions of a hungry caterpillar, such as spider and shark caterpillar. We are working really hard in phonics; oral blending and listening to and identifying environmental sounds. We are also trying really hard to write our own names! In Maths, Pre-school have begun the unit 'Subitise to 4' through games and actions, such as dice games and dot cards. We loved joining in the repeated refrains in the class story 'Goldilocks and the Three Bears'.
