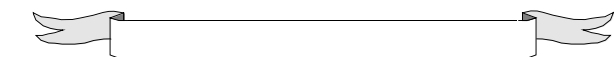

Donaldson (Class 1)

This week in Donaldson Class, we have looked at the abstract artist Paul Klee. A phrase he is famous for is about the 'the dot that went for a walk' and the children had a great time drawing a dot that went for a walk and creating a piece of abstract art with charcoal and oil pastels! We thoroughly enjoyed our transition morning and with the reception children going to Class 1 and the preschool children meeting their new friends for September. In Maths, the Reception children continued the math unit 'Visualize and build' and we created our own animal scenes using the small world and talking about what each person could see from a different perspective. Great positional language used. Reception children have been practicing the capital and lower-case letters and writing freely in the environment!



Dahl (Class 2)

This week in Dahl Class, we have enjoyed creating our own collages in the style of Brazilian artist Beatriz Milhazes. We made a space themed collage, and I was very impressed to see the amazing History and Geography knowledge coming through in their pieces. Some children made excellent links, showing the equator and Antarctica on the Earth and collaging pieces to show the 'space race' between America and Russia and key figures such as Neil Armstrong or Laika the Dog and Albert the Monkey! In PE, we practiced our throwing skills by perfecting our overarm throw and aiming accurately so that our partner can catch. We also really enjoyed our transition day despite having to get ready to lose our lovely Year 2s soon for their next step into KS2!



Suess (Class 3)

This week in Suess, we have been busily practicing for the end of year show. We have also been making electrical circuits, making motors and lights work, furthermore, using the correct symbols. In English, we have been writing our character description with the focus on expanding noun phrases, using adverbs, conjunctions, and adjectives. On Wednesday, we met our new classes, we had a fun day making gems, playing rounders in PE, and other exciting activities. Finally, we went on a wonderful trip to Birmingham to play with lots of Lego! It's been another busy one, well done Class 3!



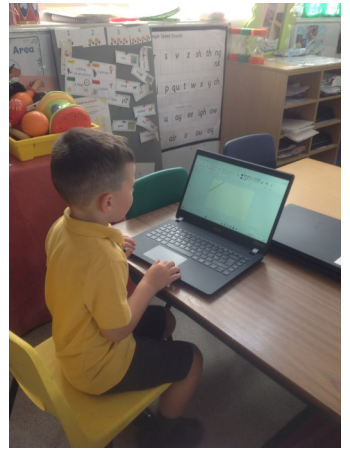
Morpurgo (Class 4)

In phonics we are continuing with recognising rhyming pairs and Fred Talk games.

In OPAL this week, we have seen the children really enjoying creating dens under the shade of the trees around the field and in Forest School. They have been really inventive setting up little areas in their dens using role play items to develop their areas! Cooking in the mud kitchen has been key so if you have any topsoil or outdated kitchen ingredients you no longer need, these will enrich our play immensely and encourage the children to use the topsoil instead of the sand pit sand to make pies!
