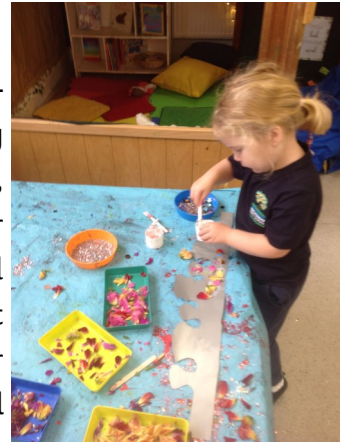


Ruby (Class 1)
