We have had a successful week and we thank you all for your efforts at home.

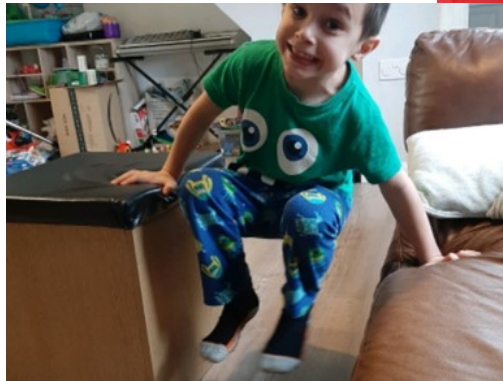

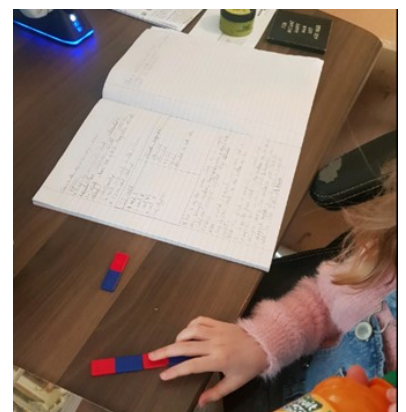


Turtles
